Dear President.

The International Economic Association decided two years ago to accept the invitation of Academicians A. Agenbegyan and O. Bogomolov (both members of its Executive Committee) to hold its Tenth World Congress in Moscow on August 24th-28th. 1992. Financial provision for the Congress was subsequently approved by the Soviet authorities.

Now we are writing on behalf of the Association to ask for your support. In particular, we hope very much that you will be willing to accept an invitation to address the Congress. The bringing together in Moscow of some 2,000 economists from all parts of the world will provide a unique opportunity for the exchange of views at this crucial time. It will lead to much better knowledge and understanding of the problems of the Russian economy, and help develop methods of value in their resolution. very hopeful that it will lead to increased cooperation and strengthen the links between economists from the West and the East.

It is planned that the Moscow Congress will be open to all areas of economics, in order to encourage the widest possible participation. There will be a broad and varied programme, which will include sessions involving related disciplines such a psychology and economic history. Five volumes of proceedings will be published as a result of the Congress. I have the pleasure to attach a copy of our Newsletter no. 19, which is entirely devoted to this event

The International Economic Association is a federation of most of the national economic associations in the world. It is the only world organisation covering the entire field of economics. Previous presidents have included such distinguished scholars as Paul Samuelson and Kenneth Arrow, both Nobel-Prize-Winners.

THE TENTH WORLD CONGRESS

MOSCOW, 24-28 AUGUST 1992

A.B. Atkinson IEA President, 1989-1992

The next World Congress of the International Economic Association is to be held in Moscow in the week beginning Monday 24 August 1992.

The Congress is being held with the support of the Soviet Government, and is being jointly organised by the Academy of National Economy (Rector: Academician A. G. Aganbegyan) and the USSR Academy of Sciences (President: Academician G. I. Marchuk), with the support of Academicians O. T. Bogomolov, T. Shatalin, and T. I. Zaslavskaya. The local arrangements for the Congress are in the hands of a Working Group organised by Professor A Modin (Vice-Rector of the Academy of National Economy.)

The Congress of the Association takes place every three years (the last was organised by my predecessor Amartya Sen in Athens in 1989). Its aim is to allow economists from all countries, and working in all areas of economics, to meet together to discuss modern developments in economic thought and methods. It is a natural place to discuss current and future economic problems, such as those faced by economies in transition.

In order to encourage the widest possible participation in the Congress, it is open to all areas of economics. There will be a broad and varied programme, and no one should feel excluded on the grounds of their particular specialism. The programme will include sessions involving related disciplines such as psychology and economic history.

PROGRAMME

The overall organisation of the Programme is the responsibility of the IEA President. The pattern of the Congress follows that in Athens in 1989 and there will he:

Plenary Addresses Full-day Parallel Sessions Half-day Parallel Sessions Round-table Discussions

The Parallel Sessions will consist of one or two Invited Papers, the purpose of which is to survey the field, and of Contributed Papers

PUBLICATION

After the Conference, the Plenary Addresses and the Invited Papers will be published, subject to refereeing, in the Proceedings volumes of the Association, published by Macmillan. The Contributed Papers will not be published.

PROGRAMME COMMITTEE

The decision-making with regard to the selection of Invited and Contributed Papers is decentralised to the Programme Committee, which will consist of expens from a variety of fields and countries. The names of the Programme Committee are to be circulated in a future Newsletter. It will be the responsibility of the Programme Committee to select the Invited Papers and to make the choice of Contributed Papers in their field

CONTRIBUTED PAPERS

Contributed papers should be submitted **before**15 January 1992 to the World Congress Programme

Those wishing to contribute a paper to the Congress should send 3 coples (in English). The paper will be allocated to a Session Organiser, who will be responsible for the selection of contributed papers and for informing the contributor of the final decision.

Many submissions are expected, and the number of slots on the Programme is very limited, so that it is recommended that papers be submitted well before the deadline of 15 January 1992. The Programme Committee will do its best to accommodate as many papers as possible, but I apologise in advance for the disappointments that may result.

BUDGET AND COSTS

The budget of the Congress is quite limited, despite generous support from the government of the USSR. Participants will have to pay a Congress fee (\$ 250 for those registering before 15 April, 1992, \$ 350 after that date) and the local costs of accommodation and participation. The Association is exploring possible sources of support to help those who would otherwise find it difficult to participate, particularly those from developing countries and younger scholars.

In view of the time required to obtain visas and make hotel bookings, participants are advised to make early arrangements for the congress.
